1. Provide a summary of the book. Address the following literary elements: characters, setting, problem, and solution.
2. What point of view is the author writing from (first person, second person, third person limited, third person omniscient)? How does this effect the story?
3. Describe the main character. Support your answer with details from the text.
4. How does the main character change throughout the book?
5. Discuss the climax of the story. Support your answer with details from the text.
6. What do you believe is the theme, or central idea, of this book?
7. Which character do you relate to the most? Why?
8. Describe your favorite part of the story. What were the characters doing, thinking, and feeling? Why is this your favorite part?
9. If your book is part of a series, what do you predict might happen in the next book?
10. Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not?
