


## **Book Talk Questions**

- 1. Provide a summary of the book. Address the following literary elements: characters, setting, problem, and solution.
- 2. What point of view is the author writing from (first person, second person, third person limited, third person omniscient)? How does this effect the story?
- 3. Describe the main character. Support your answer with details from the text.
- 4. How does the main character change throughout the book?
- 5. Discuss the climax of the story. Support your answer with details from the text.
- 6. What do you believe is the theme, or central idea, of this book?
- 7. Which character do you relate to the most? Why?
- 8. Describe your favorite part of the story. What were the characters doing, thinking, and feeling? Why is this your favorite part?
- 9. If your book is part of a series, what do you predict might happen in the next book?
- 10. Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not?
